The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Delete the word "Sanitizer" (front panel only).
2. Delete ethanol from the active ingredients. It is now considered an inert ingredient. Please adjust your percentages accordingly.
3. Include the 10-minute contact time for the disinfection section. The directions must also indicate how the product should be removed from the surface after the recommended exposure period (rinse or air dry).

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

DANGER: Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Causes severe skin irritation, especially on broken skin. Causes eye irritation if mist is swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling this product. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.
