STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

IF SWALLOWED - Move to ventilated area.
IF ON SKIN - Wash with soap and water. If irritation develops get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in serving areas while food is being prepared. Do not use in home cover or remove exposed foods. A cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces.

Foods should be removed or covered or food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. When in these areas apply only when the facility is closed.

SPACE SPRAY: To kill houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats, and flies in a room or area to be treated. Shut off ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Apply undiluted as a very fine mist space spray. Do not use in areas with operating equipment or with electrical appliances. Avoid staining by holding at least five feet from objects. Direct the spray toward the upper corner of the room. Apply a fine mist space spray at a rate of 5 cubic feet per minute. Leave room closed for 30 minutes before re-entry. Sweep up debris.

CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill roaches, ants, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes. Apply large wetting type spray particles. Direct these insects in cracks and crevices. Spray around pipes, behind cabinets, and other infested areas until thoroughly wet.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on the webbed applications to the webbing and which harbor spiders.

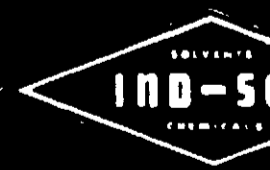
TO KILL ANTS: Spray doors, around walls and hills.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: Adults of confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles, and other grain insects. Destroy infested grain, cereal or flour and destroy other food and foodstuffs in the area. Do not spray. Spray directly on exposed surfaces and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. Dispose of all infested products. The area should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed with insecticide. Seal with shelf paper after dry. Any utensils that are contacted should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. In the home cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using this product in these areas apply only when the facility is not in operation.

SPACE SPRAY To kill houseflies, mosquitoes and gnats. Close room or area to be treated. Shut off air conditioner and ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Remove fish and pets. Apply undiluted as a very fine mist spray through manually operated equipment or with electrical and other powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least five feet from objects. Direct the fine mist space spray toward the upper corner of the room. Fill the room with a fine mist space spray at a rate of 5 fluid ounces per 5,000 cubic feet. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy insects.

CONTACT SPRAYS To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes. Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray particles. Direct spray to contact these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes, behind cabinets and other harborages. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications to the webbing and all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders.

TO KILL ANTS Spray doors around window frames, ant trails and hills.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS Adults of confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles. Remove infested grain, cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the areas by removing before spraying. Spray directly on exposed stages and into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. In homes dispose of all infested products. The shelves and drawers should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed so as to contact all pests, and covered with shelf paper after allowing shelves to dry. Any utensils that are contacted with spray should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary.
