Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

WARNING

- General weed treatment and control:**
Use at the rate of 1 to 4 gallons of solution per 1000 square feet around industrial sites, parking lots, and fenced areas.
- For regular annual weeds and grasses such as mullen, ryegrass, wild oats, foxtail, crabgrass, etc., use the solution at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons per 1000 sq. ft.
- For perennial weeds and grasses like smooth bromegrass, Canada bluegrass, broom sedge, aster, dog fennel, goldenrod, plantain and wild onion, use 1 to 5 gallons of the solution per 1000 sq. ft. For hard to kill weeds and grasses use 3 to 5 gallons of solution per 1000 sq. ft. These may include grass, bouncing bet, broken fern, Johnsrabbit, horsetail. Repeat if necessary.

WARNING: Do not apply or permit drift of this product on plant growth, food, vegetable plants, flowers, or in proximity areas use coarse spray to avoid drift onto desirable vegetation. - B. For regular annual weeds and grasses like turkey mullen, ryegrass, wild oats, foxtail, crabgrass, ragweed, use the solution at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons per 1000 sq. ft.
- C. For perennial weeds and grasses like smooth brome, Canada bluegrass, broom sedge, aster, dandelion, dog fennel, goldenrod, plantain and wild carrot, use 1 to 5 gallons of the solution per 1000 sq. ft. For hard to kill weeds and grasses use 3 to 6 gallons of solution per 1000 sq. ft. These may include saltgrass, bouncing bet, broken fern, Johnson grass and horsetail. Repeat if necessary.

WARNING: Do not apply or permit drift to desirable plant growth, food, vegetable plants, flowers, fruit trees; in proximity areas use coarse spray to avoid drift of mist onto desirable vegetation.
