CONTACT SPRAY For knockdown of the adult weevils and larvae, spray the stems or foliage with 4% tank mix of power insecticide, either carbaryl and other soil-insecticides, whiteworm spray, Captain, Dursban, using 2 to 4 gallons of liquid per acre, or 10-10-10 NPK water. Apply 1 to 2 gallons of insecticide per acre.

PLANT GROWTH IN AREAS TO BE COVERED BY PAVEMENT**

Apply 1 gallon of Ind-Sol 4G with 2 gallons of water per 150 to 200 square feet. Ind-Sol 4G may be also applied without water if desired. After application, several to inches of more mineral rainfall and/or leaching by soils and soils at high iron content, arsenic only will be reduced.

DRILL METHOD - Drills are used for large trees and large barked trees over 6 inches diameter in locations where stand density is prohibitive. Make downward slanting holes at 45° as far as possible in the trees. Drill a hole 3 to 4 inches down the trunk and extend a horizontal cut about 10 to 12 inches from the bottom of the hole.
