This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing heavy algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 75 to 116 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 41 to 75 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 13.6 to 27 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 4 to 8 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled whirlpool or hot tub, add initially 4 to 8 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. May be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals. Reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.

DO NOT MIX THIS PRODUCT WITH CONCENTRATED DRY OR LIQUID CHLORINE PREPARATIONS.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool or hot tub, add initially 4 to 8 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 3 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. May be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.
