GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label. This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, pools, spas, whirlpools and hot tubs containing algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 97 to 150 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 69 to 97 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons. Subsequent additions of 24 to 48 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 to 14 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 69 to 97 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned whirlpool or hot tub, add initially 7 to 10 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons. Subsequent additions of 2 to 5 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas at both acid and alkaline pH. May be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine. Reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.

DO NOT MIX THIS PRODUCT WITH CONCENTRATED DRY OR LIQUID CHLORINE

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of containers. Rinse that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in accordance with approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water. Open dumping is prohibited.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 97 to 150 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 69 to 97 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 24 to 48 ounces per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 10 to 15 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool or hot tub, add initially 7 to 10 fluid ounces of this product per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 5 fluid ounces should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. May be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.

DO NOT MIX THIS PRODUCT WITH CONCENTRATED DRY OR LIQUID CHLORINE PRODUCTS.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
