CLEANER-SANITIZER

FOR FARM BULK TANK: CLEANING OPERATIONS:

1. Flush with lukewarm water until ALL milk is washed out.
2. Wash with I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer solution—one (1) ounce to five (5) gallons cold water. (Provides 25 ppm titratable iodine.)
3. Brush thoroughly, drain, and rinse for 2 minutes.

SANITIZING OPERATIONS:

(Where Code permits), brush or spray the tank with I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer solution—one-quarter ounce to a 10-quart pail of cold water. (Provides 12.5 ppm titratable iodine.) Allow the solution to drain thoroughly.

FOR UDDERS: Use a clean paper towel for each cow. Wet in I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer solution—one-half ounce to a 10-quart pail of lukewarm water (90°F). (Provides 25 ppm titratable iodine.) Rinse with potable water before milking.

FOR MILKSTONE REMOVAL: Should yellow color show on equipment after the first use of I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer, milkstone is indicated. Remove it, using an I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer solution—equal parts of I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer and lukewarm water. Spread over surfaces to be cleaned; wait 2 to 3 minutes; then brush and rinse. The daily use of I-ODO-CAL Cleaner-Sanitizer will prevent the formation of milkstone.

DANGER: Causes eye damage. Causes severe skin irritation. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
