DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label. Use of this product for any purpose other than those stated on the label is prohibited. The use of this product in the manufacture and formulation of other pesticide products is prohibited.

BAF-CIDE P is a specially prepared product for controlling algae in industrial and commercial recirculating cooling towers and evaporative cooling systems. BAF-CIDE P is packaged in premeasured, one pound, single treat pouches. Each water soluble pouch is contained in a non-water soluble outer pouch from its outer bag prior to use. DO NOT OPEN INNER POUCH UNTIL READY TO USE.

COOLING TOWER, FLUID COOLER and EVAPORATIVE COOLING SYSTEMS: INITIAL DOSAGE: 6 to 12 weight ounces of BAF-CIDE P per 1000 or 2 to 4 one-pound pouches per 5000 gallons of water in the system (one pouch per 1500 gallons water in the system). Dosage depending on time of initial slug addition.

SUBSEQUENT DOSAGE: 3 to 6 weight ounces of BAF-CIDE P per 1000 gallons of water or 1 to 2 one-pound pouches per 5000 gallons of water in the system (one pouch per 2500 gallons of water in the system). Dosage is to be adjusted if microbial growth is noticed. The initial slug addition is used until control is evident. When or where microbial growths are under control, dosage may be reduced.

Place the required number of unopened one pound pouches in a nylon net, or other container allowing free movement of water around pouches in the container in the system sump or basin at a point where there is a high flow of water to allow rapid dissolution of the product and prevent damage that may result from contact of concentrated BAF-CIDE P with galvanized or aluminum surfaces.

BAF-CIDE P may be repackaged into water-soluble bags or use sodium pentachlorophenate in the formulation of other antimicrobial products. Registrants who have complied with all terms and conditions of the registration of their product as approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency under Section 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Corrosive to mild steel. Do not store or transport in unlined metal containers.
STORAGE: Store in a secure, dry area protected from extreme temperatures. Do not store in a closed container when not in use.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of spray mixtures, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes are not used according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest guidance.
