Paper Mills: For the control of fungal and yeast slimes in pulp, paper, and paperboard mills, add MARCIDE 101 at the rate of 0.2 to 0.7 lbs. per ton of dry product. Either method of addition should be made at a location that will insure uniform distribution of MARCIDE 101 in the mass of fiber and water, such as beaters, jordan inlet or discharge, broke chests, furnish chests, save-alls and white-water tanks.

Cooling Towers (Open Recirculating Systems): MARCIDE 101 controls fungal and yeast slimes on the wetted surfaces and in the recirculating water in cooling towers.
