DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For the control of fungal and yeast slimes in pulp, paper, and paperboard mills, add 5 to 20 oz. av. of MARCIDE 104 per ton of dry paper or paperboard produced or 15 to 30 oz. av. per ton of starch or clay slurry. MARCIDE 104 should be added at a point of high consistency such as the hydropulper, heater, starch or clay storage chests, where there is good mixing. A chemical metering pump is suggested with application being made either continuous or intermittent, depending upon the systems characteristics.
