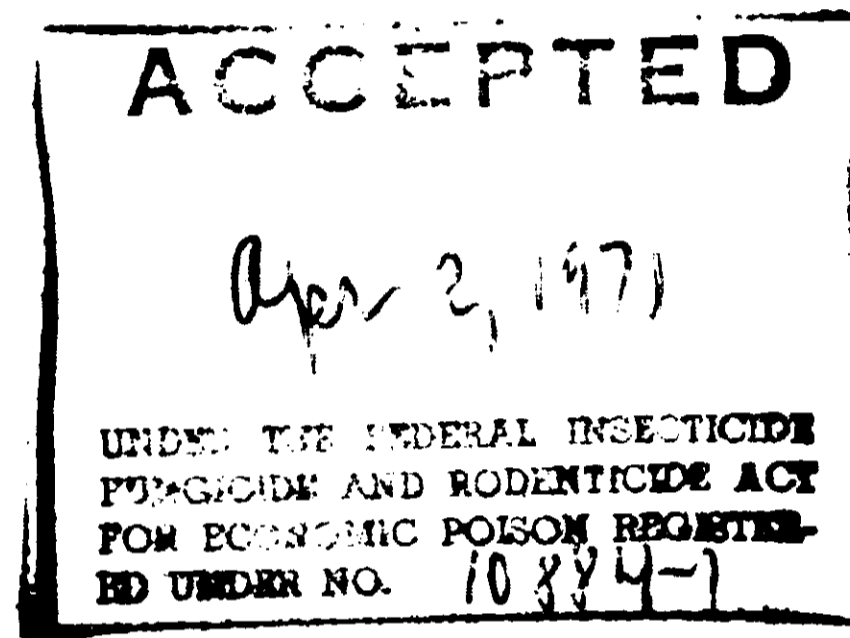

## DANGER

In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Before eating or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. Wash all contaminated clothes with soap and hot water before using them again.

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Do not contaminate food, nor the raw materials for the elaboration of same. Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin and/eyes. Do not contact the skin and/or eyes. Do not prolong exposure to vapours. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothes and goggles. Keep all unprotected persons out of operational area. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Wear mask or respirator of a type found by the U. S. Department of Agriculture to give adequate protection against this material.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

### **ANTIDOTE**

If swallowed give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep warm and quiet. **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.**

If on the skin, wash with large amount of soap and water. If inhaled remove the victim to fresh air. Keep warm and quiet. **CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.**
