SANITIZATION: When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items, limit active quaternaries to 200ppm. **POTABLE WATER RINSE** is required. **NO**

The product is an effective sanitizer when diluted in water up to 250ppm hardness (CaCO₃).

The product when diluted at the rate of 2 ounces per gallon of water is an effective disinfectant against the organism *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and meets all requirements for hospital use.

In addition, this product deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, toilet basins and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product has been designed specifically for use in food processing plants and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance.

SANITIZATION: To sanitize previously rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, 200ppm active quaternary solution of this product to 3 1/2 gallons of water.

To sanitize immobile items, such as tank blocks, counter tops, flood the area with a solution of this product, making sure to reach completely for at least 60 seconds. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

TO SANITIZE MOBILE ITEMS

1. Scrape and pre-wash utensils and glassware as far as possible. 2. Wash with a good Sanitizer wash detergent. 3. Rinse with clean water. Sanitize in a solution of 2 oz. to 3 1/2 gal. (200 ppm) immerse all utensils for at least 60 seconds or for contact time specified by government code. 4. Place sanitized utensils on drainboard to air dry.

DISINFECTION: To disinfect hard surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops), add 2 oz. product per gallon of water. Apply with scrub cloth or sponge or mechanical scrubber thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and flush. For heavily soiled areas, a cleaning step is required.

To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet, add this product directly to the bowl, wipe bowl completely using a scrub brush or making sure to get under the rim. Let stand 10 minutes and flush. For heavily soiled areas, a cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER SUPPLY
DO NOT FEED BY STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a dry place no higher than 50°F or higher than 20°F.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Triple rinse empty container. Return metal drum then offer for recycling, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary land fill or other procedure approved by State authorities. Plastic containers may be recycled in a sanitary landfill, incinerated, or disposed of by local authorities by burning. If burned, smoke.
