

Sprayon® Wasp & Hornet Killer

Directions For Use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

No. 00869 kills wasps, hornets and yellow jackets: This spray is fast acting when insects are hit directly. Allow about 24 hours for those insects which were not directly hit by spray to leave the area. If insects should return to the treated area, spray again. No. 00869 delivers a powerful food-type spray, making it possible for the operator to stay back from the places sprayed. This formulation utilizes pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and a carbamate type insecticide, a combination particularly effective on this class of insects.

- High velocity delivery valve rapidly shoots a stinging blow 6 to 10 feet. Wind should always be at user's back and toward object being sprayed. Do not stand directly under nest being treated as falling insects may fall onto skin or clothing.
- To prevent entrance of insects into buildings, spray around points where outside plumbing, faucets, enter the house and into any cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.
- Product should be sprayed in a well ventilated area.
- Direct opening of actuator toward insects wherever possible and under eaves, into nests, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed.
- Spray for about 10 seconds or until surface is moist from insecticide.
- Open and shut the valve completely. Keep your fingertip out of the spray so as not to form droplets.

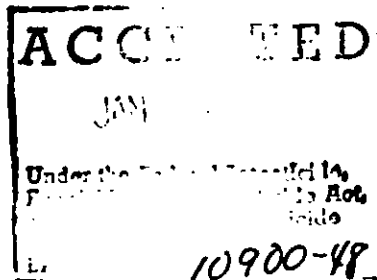
