 862 Industrial Insecticide Spray
 EPA Registration Number 10900-49
 Submission dated May 11, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Delete the phrase "Industrial Strength" which appears on the front panel of the product label. This wording is contrary to the Agency policy as put forth in PR Notice 91-7 (see enclosed copy).
2. Delete the wording "...processing and handling equipment..." which appears in the paragraph which begins "Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain..".
3. Expand the statement "DO NOT USE ON HUMANS" to read: **DO NOT USE ON HUMANS OR ANIMALS.**

862 Industrial Insecticide Spray

862 Provides rapid control of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths (Mulleins), Gnats, Wasps, and accessible stages of Roaches, Ants, Water Bugs, Silverfish, Flour Beetles, Weevils, Grain Mites and Spiders. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Directions For Use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. SHAKE BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close range.

Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, and Small Flying Moths (Mulleins): Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Centipedes and Sow Bugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Indian Meal Moths and Angoumois Grain Moths: Close doors and windows. Direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pantries and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application weekly or as needed.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, baseboards, floors, shelves and carpets. Repeat as necessary.

Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Red Flour Beetles, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers and other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes in 1 hour after treatment. Repeat applications as necessary.

Lice: Spray on garments, bedding mattresses, furniture, floors, carpeting, and inanimate surfaces. First spray an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated.

Hold can upright with nozzle away from you. Press button and spray surface to be treated from a distance of 10 inches. Spray each square foot for 3 seconds, directing spray into all infested surfaces until moist.

For Bedding: Make sure spray is directed into corners of fitted sheets and blankets as well as inside and outside of pillow cases. In the case of garments and headgear, close attention should be given to seams, hems, cuffs, collars, and creases. After treatment, bedding and all garments must be either laundered in hot water or dry cleaned as required.

For Mattresses, Furniture and Carpeting: Direct spray into all folds, tufts, seams and crevices of infested areas until moist. Allow all treated surfaces to dry completely before use.

NOT FOR USE ON HUMANS

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and frames. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Fleas: Spray sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Replace pet's old bedding. Repeat as necessary. Use only a recommended pet spray on pets.

To use entire contents: Hold sprayhead stationary and rotate can until material sprays as shown.



Precautionary Statements: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Avoid breathing of vapor or contact with eyes or skin. Vacate premises after treatment and ventilate before re-occupying. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. When using this product in food processing plants, food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment and washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before reuse. When using this product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not use in areas where fish or reptiles may be exposed to the spray. **PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees F may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed: Drink a large amount of milk or water. Do NOT induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Call a physician (or Poison Control Center) immediately. If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Disposal: Do not Reuse Empty Container. Wrap and Put in Trash Collection. **Storage:** Store in a Cool Dry Place. Keep Container Closed.
