00882 Spray Disinfectant is designed for use in homes, Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Institutions, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels.

When used as directed, 00882 Spray Disinfectant is formulated to disinfect non-porous hard surfaces (such as walls, desk tops, sink tops, telephones, door knobs, diaper pails, toilet seats, bed pans and hampers).

In addition, 00882 Spray Disinfectant deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, rest rooms, shower stalls and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

When used as directed, 00882 Spray Disinfectant demonstrates effective disinfection against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Klebsiella aerogenes and Trichophyton mentagrophytes.

The product is also effective against Pseudomonas, Vibrio, and fungi which, when used as directed, disinfects floors, walls, the bath room, shower stalls and sinks, as well as other hard, non-porous surfaces commonly contaminated by these fungi.

MOLD AND MILDEWSTAT - 00882
Spray Disinfectant prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces when used as directed.

Directions

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SURFACE DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZATION

- To remove soil deposits from surface to be treated.
- Hold can six inches from surface and spray until completely wet, allowing the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

AIR DEODORIZER AND AIR REFRESHER

- Point spray upwards to center of room and spray for 10 seconds.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surfaces to be treated. Make sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals when mildew growth reappears.

Precautionary Statements: Irritant to skin, eyes & respiratory system. **WARNING: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing - Harmful if swallowed.

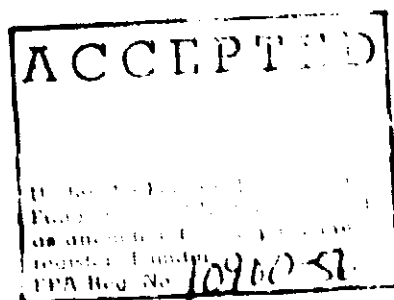

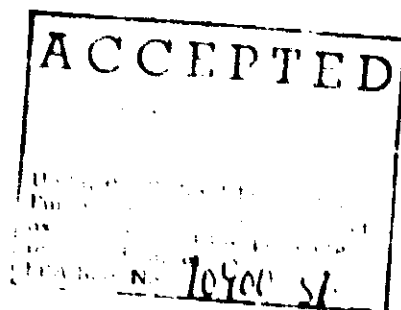
