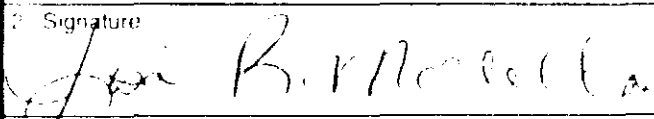

Directions For Use. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT, APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

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Indoors — To kill flies, houseflies, small flying moths, beetles and wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 3-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Spray up and destroy 18-hour larvae.

After spraying, residents must take certain precautions. During the time between spraying and the next spraying, residents must take the following precautions:

- If there are cracks, holes and crevices, correct as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, around doors and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat coars, sealed window frames, and walls and other areas of entry. Repeat at 0601547.

1. Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rug and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

In all exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetle, Saw-toothed Grain Beetle, and Rice Weevil: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces and recesses, behind doors and window frames.

In 10 Feet and 30 Feet by 10 Feet Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets around baseboards, window and door frames, wet cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

02900003 — To Reduce Abundance of Mosquitoes, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Nuisance Spray area infested with these flying insects. Mail container 12-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving spray from the infested areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupancy of the infested area. Repeat as necessary.

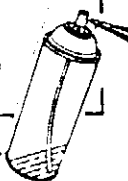

Caution: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants. WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat at needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
