DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To be used indoors wherever these insects are an annoyance: in Food Processing Plants, Restaurants, Hospitals, Homes, Stores, Hotels, Schools, and other Public Buildings; in Dairies, Barns, Canneries, Breweries and Food Handling Establishments.

This product is designed for use in automatically-timed discharging devices. Using the metered valve provided, which gives a dosage of 100 mgs. set to discharge every fifteen minutes, one unit will control flies, mosquitoes, gnats and flying moths in an area of approximately 6000 cubic feet. Factors such as shape of area, temperature, humidity and air currents all affect insect activity and may modify the exact area protected. Insect control will build up within 2 hours after unit is in operation.

Used as described, this 12 ounce can contains sufficient insecticide to operate 24 hours a day for 34 days. This will provide for monthly replacement. Any remaining contents may be used manually.

To use manually, remove cap and direct spray at flies or other insects, pressing actuator button repeatedly. To treat entire area, close windows and doors and press actuator button 7 times per 1000 cubic feet of space while moving about to distribute the spray in the upper portion of the room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes and ventilate before reoccupying.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

DISPOSAL

Keep container and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate.

- e. The piperonyl butoxide, technical footnote should be revised to read "14.18% and 3.55%."
- f. Supply the flash point/Flame extension for this product.
- g. The precautionary statement should be revised to read something like the following:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. Wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

- h. The disposal statement should be revised accordingly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
