The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Please check with your supplier concerning the percentages listed for N,N-diethyl-m-tolamide and other isomers. Based on our figures, the 23.75% would cover both Deet and the other isomers.

Submit the storage stability study referred to in Mr. Hutton's letter of May 31, 1990.

Directions For Use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel the insects listed on the Front Panel, first remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglasses frames, and such fabric as acetate rayon.
