Dear Ms. McClellan:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Remove the phrase "apply liberally" wherever it appears on both labels. This phrase is not consistent with the intent of he DEET LIP.
- 2) Remove the phrase "New Formula" from the label of 856 Insect Repellent II. There has been no recent change in formula to justify such a claim.
- 3) Change the Caution statement on the back label to "CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN".

Although we still encourage inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to exclude the statement from your labels, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellant with you". You do not need to submit an amendment to remove this from your labels.
