Dear Mr. Zajac,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Sherwin Williams Company's last label approval stamped April 9, 1992 listed the following stipulation as part of the registration acceptance:

1) Remove the phrase "apply liberally" wherever it appears on both labels. This phrase is not consistent with the intent of the DEET LIP.

The language that was required to be removed on April 9, 1992 must also be removed from all locations on the label submission dated March 21, 2001. These instructions provide a potential for overuse and unnecessary user exposure.

2. The line listed as "Other Isomers..... 1.25%" within the Active Ingredients section should be indented underneath of DEET to denote that Other Isomers are a part of DEET, and not an independent active ingredient.
3. The statement "Company Name" is not adequate. The Agency Label review manual states the following:

"The company name and address of the registrant must be on the pesticide product label. The name and address should be that of the manufacturer and can be preceded by "Manufactured by...." If the registrant is not the manufacturer (producer), the name and address must be qualified by the phrase "Manufactured for..." to indicate that the name shown is not the producer. The name and address must be displayed prominently and within the range of type size that is required for all label text. The name and address may be placed anywhere on the label, but is preferred on the front panel."

You **must** replace this with the complete company name and address.

Directions For Use: Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this product with you. Do not spray in enclosed areas. If used on the face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel the insects listed on the front panel, first remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing.

Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-exposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabric as acetate rayon.

Precautionary Statements: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF YOUNG CHILDREN AND INFANTS. Do not spray on face, lips or into eyes. In case of contact with eyes, flush with water. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause eye irritation.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Extremely Flammable! Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degree F may cause bursting.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
