DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS PRODUCT LABEL.

Remove protective cap from can. Hold can at least 12 inches away from skin and/or clothing to be treated, and spray with a slow sweeping motion. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Do not allow children to handle this product. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water.

TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray palm of hand first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

WORKS ON OUTER SURFACES OF CLOTHING: Do not use under clothing. Spray shirts, pants, socks, and hats. For ticks and chiggers, also spray cuffs, socks and around other openings in outer clothing. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again.

Will not damage cotton, wool, or nylon. Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, spandex or other synthetic (other than nylon), furniture, plastics, watch crystals, leather and painted or varnished surfaces including automobiles.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS
