You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.



You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance

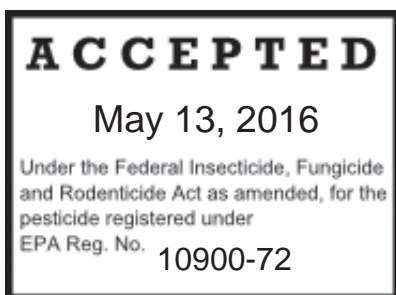

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read and follow all Directions and Precautions on this Product Label.

Remove protective cap from can. Hold can at least 12 inches away from skin and/or clothing to be treated, and spray with a slow sweeping motion. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Do not allow children to handle this product. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin, and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water.

To Apply to Face: Spray palm of hand first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

Works on Outer Surfaces of Clothing: Do not use under clothing. Spray shirts, pants, socks and hats. For ticks and chiggers, also spray cuffs, socks and around other openings in outer clothing. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again.

Will not damage cotton, wool or nylon. Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, spandex or other synthetic (other than nylon) furniture, plastics, watch crystals, leather and painted or varnished surfaces including automobiles.

Hazards to Humans
