Do not spray in a period of not less than 3 minutes after spraying. Spray for 10 seconds. Push button to spray. Move arm from side to side in a figure 8 pattern.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN BUILDINGS, VEHICLES AND OTHER ENCLOSED AREAS

FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

For Use By Department of Defense

To Kill Flying Insects (Mosquitoes, Houseflies and Caribbees): Spray 3 feet from any surface, holding dispenser above the surface. Do not spray in a confined space. Do not spray in a period of not less than 3 minutes after spraying. Ten seconds per cubic foot (10 feet x 10 feet x 10 feet). Keep treated area closed to prevent re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Cockroaches: Contact as many insects as possible. Spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring cockroaches. Pay particular attention to cracks, hidden surfaces and where these pests are most likely to hide.
