This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 10900-96".
 - b. Relocate "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" to appear directly above the signal word "CAUTION". There should be no colon after the signal word and the general arrangement should be as it is on the label for the companion product, EPA Reg. No. 10900-68. [Note: The quotation marks appearing around text revisions specified in this Notice should not appear on your revised labeling.]

- c. This product appears to be intended for indoor use in the home. If that is the case, then the front panel must state **For Indoor Household Use Only** and revise the beginning of the second sentence of the introductory paragraph to read: "This is a multipurpose indoor household-use insecticide ...". You may then delete the "Environmental Hazards" heading and associated text, as well as deleting "Do not apply this pesticide in the immediate area when occupants are present. Do not apply this pesticide when classrooms are in use." from the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section.
- d. In the introductory paragraph on the back panel, revise "kills Beetles" to "kills Carpet Beetles" and revise "Ticks" to "Brown Dog Ticks" in this same section.
- e. In the first paragraph following the heading "Directions for Use", add "Apply as a localized surface spray only. Do not use on plants. Use only in well-ventilated areas." after "Do not use as a space spray.". You may then delete "Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only." from the "Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals" section.
- f. In the directions for control of ants, etc., add a semicolon after "cabinets", since this sets apart the group of sites which should be sprayed "behind and beneath".
- g. Also in the directions for control of ants, etc., delete "and other utility installations", since this could be construed as recommending spraying into areas where electrical contact could occur, which is not acceptable for a water-based product. Before the sentence beginning "Pests driven out ...", add the following: "Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. Before spraying this product, remove or cover all exposed food, and remove pets and cover fish aquariums. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during spraying or thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. Do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. Do not use in conduits, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes.". You may then delete from the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section: "Do not allow spray to contact food, foodstuffs, or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product.".
- h. Revise the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section to read as follows (this incorporates the above revisions, as well as the results of the toxicology studies on the product that you indicated your product is based upon):

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before smoking or eating. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result, consult a physician. Do not spray household pets or humans with this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

- i. In the "Statement of Practical Treatment", revise the last sentence of the "If Swallowed" advice to read "Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person."
- j. At the end of the "Statement of Practical Treatment", add the following "Note to Physician":

Note to Physician: This product contains an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

Kills on contact and its continuous killing action lasts up to two weeks. This is a multipurpose insecticide that also kills Beetles, Centipedes, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Pillbugs, Spiders, Ticks, Waterbugs and Silverfish.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake Well Before Use. To operate hold can upright, direct orifice toward the surface to be treated and press the actuator button. Do not use as a space spray.

To kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Pillbugs, Silverfish and Spiders: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards and

door sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Beets driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, and nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Exposure above 130°F may cause bursting. **Disposal:** Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
