RESCUE Ant & Roach Killer

Kills on contact, and its continuous killing action lasts up to two weeks. This is a multipurpose indoor household-use insecticide that kills the pests listed below.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake Well Before Use. To operate hold can upright, direct orifice toward the surface to be treated and press the actuator button. Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a localized surface spray only. Use only in well-ventilated areas.

To Kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Pillbugs, Silverfish and Spiders: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards and door sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans and plumbing. Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated sur-

faces. Before spraying this product, remove or cover all exposed food, and remove pets and cover fish aquariums. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during spraying or thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. Do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. Do not use in conduits, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, and nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.
