For polyethylene glycol just water and polyurethane with an initial dose of 1×10^6 to 7×10^6 per 10,000 g of water and fresh water collected daily, gently stirred for treatment of a 100% cleaned and fixed product initially 10^6 to 10^7 and a dose of 10^6 to 10^7 per 10,000 g of water. Subsequent addition of 1×10^6 to 10^7 and a dose of 10^6 to 10^7 per 10,000 g of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just used to allow growth to begin in hot tubs of $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{1}{4}$ fluid ounces of POLY-CIDE _____ per 10 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{1}{4}$ fluid ounces of _____ POLY-CIDE _____ per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent addition of $\frac{1}{8}$ to $\frac{1}{4}$ fluid ounces of _____ POLY-CIDE _____ should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

POLY-CIDE _____ is compatible with the chlorine calcium normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH.

POLY-CIDE _____ can be used in pools and hot tubs treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix POLY-CIDE _____ with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Rinate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.
