AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard is for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It includes requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency procedures. This label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and the Worker Protection Standard. The requirements in this box only apply to agricultural use and are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the re-entry interval (REI) if 12 hours.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

To contain spill: If liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

If product (or spray solution) is allowed to dry on combustible substances, sodium chlorate can act as an oxidizing agent increasing chance of combustion.
