HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Causes eye and skin damage. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not take internally. Causes allergic skin reaction.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. BRITZ BT SULPUR 25 D is a biological insecticide intended for use against chewing larvae (caterpillars) of certain lepid-optorous species.

Apply recommended amounts when air is calm, using ground equipment, aircraft, or hand duster. Apply at first sign of infestation and repeat at weekly intervals when needed to maintain control. Good underleaf coverage is essential since the insect must ingest BT Sulfur 25 Dust. After eating BT Sulfur 25 Dust, some insects stop feeding but may otherwise appear to be unaffected for several days. Use the higher recommendations against very heavy infestations, or where it is difficult to obtain good coverage due to rank foliage. BT Sulfur 25 Dust is exempt from tolerance requirements, and may be applied in recommended amounts up to the day of harvest.

CAUTION: Applications of sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of high summer temperatures. Do not make applications within 2 weeks of an oil spray. Do not use or allow this material to drift onto sulfur sensitive Melons, Squash, Cucumbers, Apricots, Spinach or other plants which may be injured by sulfur. Concord and other labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur.

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APPLICATION RATE

For the control of Cabbage Looper on Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Collards, Kale, Hustard and Turnip Greens,; Celery, Lettuce, Melons, Potatoes, Spinach, Tomatoes and Cucumbers (Southeastern U.S. only) apply 25 to 50 lbs. per acre.

For the control of Imported Cabbage, Worm on Broccoli, Cabbage, Caulitiquer, Collards, Kale and Mustard and Turnip Creens, apply 15 to 25 lbs. pvr acre.

For the control of Grape Leaf Folder, Umnivorous Leaf Roller, Powdery Mildew on Grapes, apply 25 to 50 lbs. per acre.

For the control of Hernworm on Tobacco and Tomatoes, apply 12 to 25 lbs. per acre.

STORAGE AN DISPOSAL

Posticide Storage: Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original container only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Do not contaminate other posticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills. Call: CHEMTREC (800) 424-9300.

To Confine Spills If dry material, cover to prevent disportal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.
