


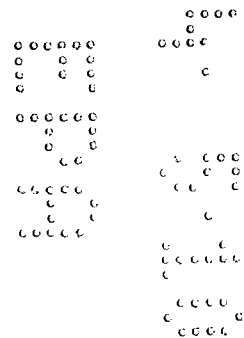

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Applicators and other handlers must wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, shoes plus socks and protective eyewear. Mixers/loaders and applicators must wear a dust/mist filtering respirator meeting NIOSH standards of at least N-95, R-95, or P-95. Repeated exposure to high concentrations of microbial proteins can cause allergic sensitization.

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

ENGINEERING CONTROLS STATEMENTS

This product must not be applied aerially within 1/4 mile of any habitats of endangered or threatened lepidoptera (i.e. moths or butterflies). No manual application can be made within 300 feet of any threatened or endangered lepidoptera.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 24 hours.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is: coveralls, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, shoes plus socks, and protective eyewear.

PHT BT 25 Sulfur Dust is a biological insecticide intended for use against chewing larvae (caterpillars) of certain lepidopterous species.

Apply recommended amounts when air is calm, using ground equipment, aircraft, or hand duster. Apply at first sign of infestation and repeat at weekly intervals when needed to maintain control. Good underleaf coverage is essential since the insect must ingest PHT BT 25 Sulfur Dust. After eating PHT BT 25 Sulfur Dust, some insects stop feeding, but may otherwise appear to be unaffected for several days. Use the higher recommendations against very heavy infestations, or where it is difficult to obtain good coverage due to rank foliage. PHT BT 25 Sulfur Dust is exempt from tolerance requirements, and may be applied in recommended amounts up to the day of harvest.

Avoiding spray drift at the application site is the responsibility of the applicator. The interaction of many equipment-and-weather-related factors determine this potential for spray drift. The applicator and the grower/treatment coordinator are responsible for considering all of these factors when making decisions.

CAUTION: Applications of sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of high summer temperatures. Do not make applications within 2 weeks of an oil spray. Do not use or allow this material to drift onto sulfur sensitive melons, squash, cucumbers, apricots, spinach or other plants which may be injured by sulfur. Concord and other labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur.

DO NOT MIX OR DILUTE WITH OTHER PRODUCTS.

THOROUGH COVERAGE ESSENTIAL WHEN USING PHT BT 25 SULFUR DUST

APPLICATION RATE:

For control of cabbage looper on broccoli, cabbage, cauliflower, collards, kale, mustard and turnip greens, celery, lettuce, melons, potatoes, spinach, tomatoes, apply 25 to 50 lbs. per acre.

For control of imported cabbage worm, on broccoli, cabbage, cauliflower, collards, kale, mustard and turnip greens, apply 15 to 25 lbs. per acre.

For control of grape leaf folder, omnivorous leaf roller, powdery mildew on grapes, apply 25 to 50 lbs. per acre.

For control of hornworm on tobacco and tomatoes, apply 12 to 25 lbs. per acre.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original container only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

In Case of Spill: Avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills. Call Chemtrec 1-800-424-8300.

To Contain Spill: If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

For Minor Spills, Leaks, Etc.: Follow all precautions indicated on this label and clean up immediately. Take special care to avoid contamination of equipment and facilities during cleanup procedures and disposal of waste.
