APPLICATION RATE:

GRAPES: Powdery mildew, Bunch Rots - Use 20 lbs. per acre. Apply when berries start to touch and thereafter as needed. Britz Copper Sulfur 15-25 Dust must be applied before the disease appears.

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**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original container only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
