## HAZARDS TO HUMANS &amp; DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**WARNING:** Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. May cause skin sensitization reaction in certain individuals. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust.

## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Mixers, loaders, applicators and other handlers must wear the following: long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, shoes plus socks and protective eyewear (goggles or faceshield). ## APPLICATION RATE:

**GRAPES:** Powdery mildew, Bunch Rots - Use 20 lbs. per acre. Apply when berries start to touch and thereafter as needed. PHT Copper Sulfur 15-25 Dust must be applied before the disease appears. Allow at least 3 days between applications. Do not apply more than 133 pounds per acre per year.

## STORAGE &amp; DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original container only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**In Case of Spill:** Avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills. Call Chemtrec 1-800-424-9300.

**To Confine Spill:** If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.
