
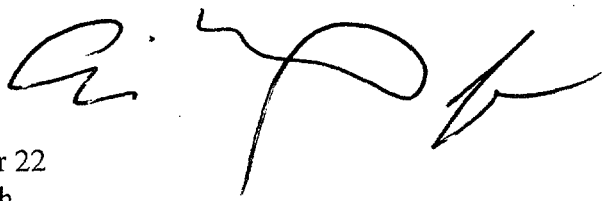

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2) The ingredients statements must be changed to:

Copper Oxychloride CAS # 1332-65-6 ... 18.69%

Basic Copper Sulfate CAS # 1344-73-6... 6.90%

Sulfur... 25.00%

Other ingredients... 49.41%

3) Change the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements to "Warning Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin."

4) The text "Wash the outside of gloves before removing" must be added to the User Safety Recommendations text currently on the label.

5) Change the Environment Hazards statements to "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates and may contaminate water through runoff. This product has a potential for runoff for several months or more after application. Poorly draining soils and soils with shallow water tables are more prone to product runoff that contains this product. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinseate."

6) Change the REI to "48 hrs."

7) Under "precaution" change "recommended amount" to "directed amount". To the application section add "maximum annual application rate is 20 lbs. metallic copper per acre per year. The minimum retreatment interval is 3 days".

8) Update the Container Disposal language to comply with PR Notice 2007-4. To the Warranty section add "to the extent consistent with applicable law" in front of "Britz Fertilizer, Inc. neither makes," and "critical and unforeseeable".

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. You must submit one copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this letter or the next round of printing must bear the new revised label. If these EPA conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these EPA Reg. conditions. This label supersedes all other previously accepted labels. WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. May cause skin sensitization reaction in certain individuals. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Mixers, loaders, applicators, and other handlers must wear the following: long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, shoe plus socks and protective eyewear (goggles or face shield). Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are natural rubber. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other person, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR, Part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forest, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 24 hours.

APPLICATION RATE:

GRAPES: Powdery mildew, Bunch Rots - Use 20 lbs. per acre. Apply when berries start to touch and thereafter as needed. Britz Copper Sulfur 15-25 Dust must be applied before the disease appears.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original container only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills. Call: CHEMTREC (800) 424-9300.

To Confine Spill: If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

For minor spills, leaks, etc., follow all precautions indicated on this label and clean up immediately. Take special care to avoid contamination of equipment and facilities during cleanup procedures and disposal of waste.
