

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

USE PRECAUTIONS:

Do not apply to sulfur-sensitive crops or varieties. Do not apply during periods of extreme heat.

PEACHES, NECTARINE:

For the control of Blossom blight [*Monilinia*], apply 60 lbs. per acre at pink bud and full bloom. For the control of Fruit decay [*Monilinia*] Brown rot and *Rhizopus* fruit rot apply 60 lbs. per acre. Apply 18, 10 and 1 day prior to harvest. Allow one day between application and harvest.

SWEET CHERRY:

For the control of Blossom blight [*Monilinia*] apply 50 lbs. per acre. Apply at popcorn, bloom, full bloom and petal fall.

GRAPES:

For the control of *Botrytis* rot, Powdery mildew, apply 30 lbs. per acre. Begin application while clusters are still loose and repeat application at two week intervals. Allow one day between application and harvest. Caution: Concord and other labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur.
