PERMISSION FOR PESTICIDE USE VARIANCE NO. 94-75 AMENDED*

Pursuant to Sections 12972 and 12976 of the Food and Agricultural Code, and responding to a special local need, permission is granted to use the pesticides, Diuron and oil (summer), in a manner not shown on the registered labeling.

Variance: Use with oil not on registered labeling for Diuron.

This use is subject to the following conditions:

Location: San Joaquin County
Pesticides: Diuron and oil
Pest: Knotweed
Crop: Asparagus
Volume per acre: Do not use in less than 50 gallons of water per acre.
Dosage: Not to exceed 5.0 pounds actual Diuron with 1 gallon 98% oil per acre.
Method of application: Ground rig

BEST DOCUMENT AVAILABLE

Field reentry safety interval: Until spray dries (need not exceed 24 hours).

All applicable label directions, restrictions, and precautions are to be followed.

A permit must be obtained from the County Agricultural Commissioner prior to the possession or use of the pesticide under this variance.

The user must have a copy of this use variance in his possession at the time the material is mixed and applied.

This variance does not constitute a recommendation of the Department of Food and Agriculture and will not prevent quarantine action if illegal residues are found on or in the crop. The user assumes all risks.

A grower who has contracted with a processor should check to determine if the application of this pesticide is acceptable under the terms of his contract.

Expiration date: December 31, 1975, unless revoked sooner.

*NOTE: Pesticide Use Variance No. 94-75, issued May 9, 1975, is superseded by this amendment.
