Repeat as necessary or as noted. Keep container tightly capped and use the contents within 6 months of opening.

ROSES and FLOWERS: AZALEA, CAMELLIA, CHRYSANTHEMUM, CARNATION, GLADIOLA, LILAC, RHODODENDRON: Aphids, Flea Beetles, Dipterous Leafminers, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Spider Mites, Thrips, Whiteflies. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water. Penetrate dense foliage. **DO NOT USE ON** Ferns, Poinsetta, Hibiscus, Papaya, Pilea, Gardenia, Orchids since injury may occur.

TREES and SHRUBS: ARBORVITAE, BIRCH, BOXWOOD, HOLLY, JUNIPER*, LOCUST, MAPLE, MIMOSA*, OAK, PINE, POPLAR, SPRUCE, WILLOW: Aphids, Bagworms, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Scale Crawlers, Webworms. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water. *Mimosa Webworms; After the first application, spray twice at 4-5 week intervals. Tent Caterpillars, Webworms (COTTONEASTER; Fall); Mix 3 oz. in 3 gallons water.

CITRUS: GRAPEFRUIT, LEMONS, ORANGES: Citrus Thrips, Scale Crawlers, Cotton-cushion. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water. Apply after blooming and repeat at 7-10 day intervals if required. Citrus Snow Scale; Mix 2 oz. in 3 gallons water. Apply post bloom and again as Summer spray. Thorough coverage of trunk, limbs and twigs is essential. **LAST APPLICATION BEFORE HARVEST: 21 DAYS.**

VEGETABLES: BEANS, PEAS: Aphids, Beetles (Cucumber, Mexican Bean), Mites. **CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BROCCOLI, RADISHES:** Aphids, Flea Beetles, Imported Cabbageworm, Dipterous Leafminer, Mites. **CANTALOUPE, CUCUMBER, SQUASH:** Aphids, Thrips, Mites. **TOMATOES, PEPPERS:** Aphids, Fall Armyworm (Tomato), Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Southern Armyworm and Vinegar Flies (Tomato). **SWEET CORN:** Aphids, Flea Beetles, Grasshoppers, Mites. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water to cover approx. 1000 sq. ft. of garden area. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals if required. Do not feed treated vines to livestock. **LAST APPLICATION BEFORE HARVEST: 1 DAY—Peas, Tomatoes, Sweet Corn; 3 DAYS—Cantaloupes, Squash; 5 DAYS—Broccoli, Cauliflower; 7 DAYS—Beans, Cabbage, Cucumbers, Peppers; 10 DAYS—Carrots, Lettuce, Radishes.**

FRUIT TREES: APPLES, PEARS, PEACHES, NECTARINES; Aphids, Codling Moth*, Fruit Leaf Roller*, Maggots (Apples), Mites (European Red*, Two-spotted Spider), San Jose Scale Crawlers. *Apples, Pears only. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water. Apply after blooming as a full cover spray and repeat at 7-10 day intervals if required. Slight russeting may occur on some varieties of apples such as Golden Delicious. **LAST APPLICATION BEFORE HARVEST: 10 DAYS—Nectarines; 14 DAYS—Apples, Pears; 21 DAYS—Peaches.**

NUISANCE PESTS: OUTSIDE AREAS: Ants, Boxelderbugs, Brown-dog Ticks, Clover Mites, Chiggers, Crickets, Cockroaches, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millipedes, Pillbugs, Springtails, Spiders. Mix 8 oz. in 3 gallons water. Spray a 5 ft. band of soil around the foundation of the house and to a height of 2-3 ft. Thoroughly spray window sills, foundations, porch walls, garbage cans and into cracks and other places insects can hide. Do not treat plants or animals.

LAWNS: BENT, BERMUDA, BLUEGRASS, DICHONDRA, FESCUE, ST. AUGUSTINE: Ants, Armyworms, Chiggers, Chinchbugs (LAWNS), Cutworms, Crickets, Lawn Billbugs, Mites (Bermuda, Clover), Sod Webworms, Sowbugs, Billbugs*. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water for each 125 sq. ft. *In North if Chinchbugs are the only problem. Mix 1 oz. in 3 gallons water for each 250 sq. ft. For lawn Billbugs, water thoroughly after treatment.
