DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHADE TREES, FLOWERS, SHRUBS; (Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Chrysanthemums, Crepe Myrtle, Dahlias, Delphinium, Fuchsias, Roses, Snapdragons, Stocks, Sweet Peas) - Black Spot of Rose, Leaf Spots, Powdery Mildew, Rust: Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray when foliage or disease appear. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals or as necessary.

APPLES, PEARS - Powdery Mildew: Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray when buds swell. Repeat when fruit buds show color and again at petal fall.

APRICOTS - Shothole: Mix 1 Tsp. per gallon or water. Apply in delayed dormant period (during January in West Coast areas). Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as necessary.

NECTARINES, PEACHES, PLUMS - Leaf Blight, Leaf Curl, Powdery Mildew, Shothole: Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water. Apply in late fall (Nov.15-Dec.15 in West Coast areas). Repeat when buds begin to swell in the spring. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as necessary.

WALNUTS - Leaf Spots: Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray after blooms drop and nut is well set. Repeat at 2 week intervals as necessary.

CITRUS - Blue Mold, Brown Rot: Mix 3 Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray lower part of tree during winter months. Sooty Mold: Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray when disease appears and repeat as necessary.

BLACKBERRIES, RASPBERRIES, STRAWBERRIES - Leaf Spots, Powdery Mildew: Mix 1-1½ Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray when disease appears and repeat as necessary.

TOMATOES - Powdery Mildew: Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray before disease appears. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as necessary.

BEANS - Powdery Mildew, Rust: Mix 1½ Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray before disease appears. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as necessary.

CUCUMBERS - Powdery Mildew: Mix 1½ Tbsp. per gallon water. Begin when foliage appears. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as necessary.

MELONS; Cantaloupe, Cassaba, Honey Ball, Honeydew, Muskmelon, Persian Melon, Watermelon - Powdery Mildew: Mix 1½ Tbsp. per gallon water. Spray before disease appears. Repeat at 7-10 intervals as necessary.
