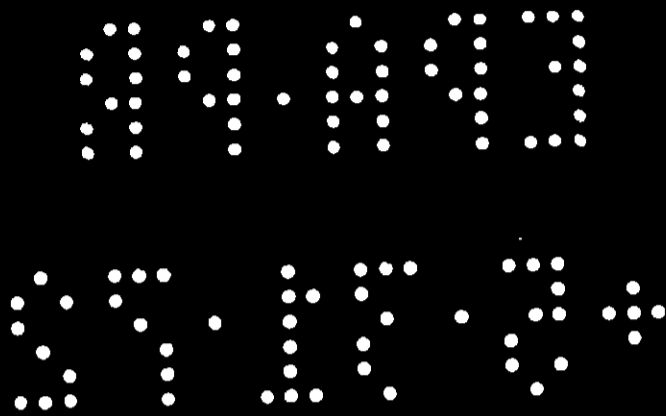

DIRECTIONS

GENERAL USE — To protect wood against termites and a wood decay or rot. Used for such items as fenceposts, mudsills, bridge timbers, telephone poles and other wood that is to be used in contact with the soil.

METHOD OF APPLICATION — Wood to be used should be free from bark, dry and well seasoned. Immerse in creosote for 12-48 hours so that the portion to be in contact with the soil is covered to at least six inches above the ground level. Structural timbers, shingles, fence rails and similar uses where wood is not to be used in contact with the ground should be immersed in Creosote for 3 minutes or painted on the surface with 3 flowing coats by means of brush or spray.

WARNING

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing.

Avoid breathing of vapors.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

Do not allow water used for cleaning equipment, tools, etc., to contaminate water for domestic consumption, irrigation or fish and wildlife. This product is toxic to fish.

Stir or shake well before using.

Use with adequate ventilation.

Not adulterated and will congeal during cold weather. Congealing may be prevented by storing in a warm place until contents are liquid.

It is illegal to open this container for resale of contents.

Contents must be sold in original, unopened and labeled container.
