## STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Dilute by giving 2 glasses of water to drink and call a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. Consult a physician if irritation persists.

**IF ON SKIN:** Wash affected skin areas with soap and water.

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

## RE-ENTRY AND WORKER PROTECTION STATEMENTS

After dusts have settled, do not enter or allow entry into treated areas until the 24-hour reentry interval has expired unless wearing the personal protective equipment listed on the label.

### WORKER SAFETY RULES:

Keep all unprotected persons, children, livestock, and pets away from treated areas where there is danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. See First Aid (Practical Treatment Section).

**PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:** For Mixers, Loaders, Applicators and Early Reentry Workers.

Handle this product only when wearing the following protective clothing and equipment: a long-sleeve shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands, and feet; chemical resistant gloves; shoes, socks, and gaiters or a face shield. During application from a tractor with a completely enclosed cab with positive pressure filtration, or aerially with an enclosed cockpit, a long-sleeve shirt and long pants may be worn in place of the above protective clothing. Chemical resistant gloves must be available in the cab or cockpit and worn while exiting.

**IMPORTANT!** Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking or drinking. Always wash hands and arms with soap and water before using the toilet.

After work take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes. Do not use contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with maneb must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

### STORAGE

Keep away from fire and sparks. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Do not allow to become wet or overheated in storage; decomposition, impaired activity, or fire may result. Keep container closed when not in use.

Pallets of containers should not be stacked more than three high. Provide access aisle for each two rows. Decomposition produces a foul odor; if observed, check for hot containers and immediately remove to open areas for disposal.

**CAUTION:** Certain plants are sensitive to sulphur. Do not use sulphur unless label directions are followed. Do not use during extreme high temperatures (above 90°F) as fire may occur. Do not apply within 100 feet of buildings.

**GROUND OR AIR APPLICATION:** Dusts should be applied with adequate coverage. For further details of application consult your Agricultural Station authority.

**Sugar Beets:** Cercospora Mildew. Use 20 to 25 lbs. per acre. Conditions favor disease infection intervals while disease conditions are present.
