# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Apply recommended amounts when air is calm, using ground equipment, aircraft or hand duster. Apply at first sign of infestation and repeat at weekly intervals when needed to maintain control. Good underleaf coverage is essential since the insect must ingest THURICIDE\*HP-144M Dust. After eating THURICIDE\*HP-144M Dust, some ir sects stop feeding but may other-

wise appear to be unaffected for several days.

Use the higher recommendations against very heavy infestations, or where it is difficult to obtain good coverage due to rank foliage. THURICIDE HP-144M Dust is exempt from tolerance requirements, and may be applied in recommended amounts up to the day of harvest.
