### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

may be harmful or fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

#### FIRST AID TREATMENT

In case of any suspected poisoning, either internal or external, consult a physician immediately.

If swallowed, drink one to two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If patient is not breathing, start artificial respiration immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Propetamphos, an organophosphate compound is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine or atropine with obidoxime hydrochloride is the emergency antidote.

In case of skin contact, remove patient from area. Remove all contaminated clothing and wash skin gently and repeatedly with soap and water.

In case of eye contact, flush immediately with water. Continue flushing for at least 15 minutes.
