The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

We are accepting your label at this time because of the hardship situations posed by the leaking containers, however the label does not meet current standards. Submit five (5) finished printed labels four months from the date of this letter incorporating the following corrections:

1. The directions for use should go under the heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE."
2. Immediately below the directions for use heading should be the statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."
3. The word POISON must be in red.
4. The precautionary paragraph should be immediately preceded by the signal word, "DANGER: HAZARD to HUMANS and DOMESTIC ANIMALS."
5. The following precautionary statement is correct for your product: Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, or skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed."
6. All storage and disposal instructions should be grouped and appear under the heading "Storage and Disposal." This heading must be set in type of the same minimum size as required for the child hazard warning.
7. Correct the spelling of "emulsifiers" as indicated on the edited label.

8. The use of the word "institutional" makes your product subject to the Child Resistant Packaging (CRP) regulation (40 CFR 162.16) which was first published in the Federal Register, Vol. 44, No. 48, pp 13019.24 on March 9, 1979, and became effective for products released for shipment after March 9, 1981. If you do not intend to use CRP, you must remove from the label all references to "institutional" use (because this term includes places like schools, motels, hotels, and restaurants) unless you use the following statement "only for Sale to Use, and Storage by Service Persons." This statement must be in type at least as large as the child hazard warning statement.

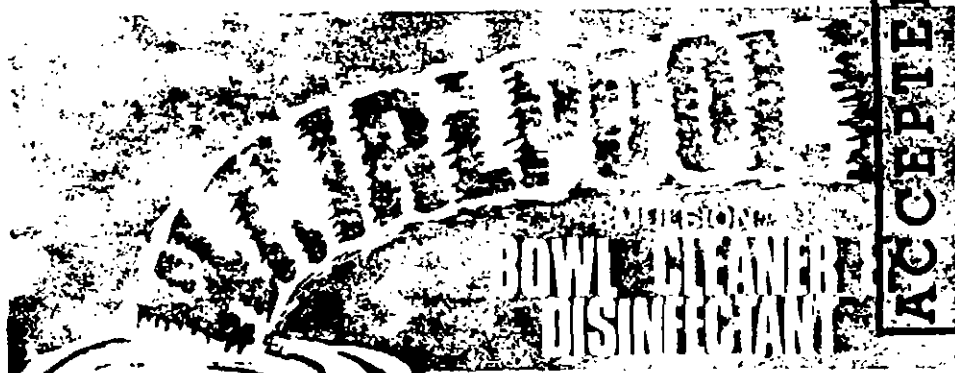
An edited label is enclosed as a suggested version, also a labeling enclosure.

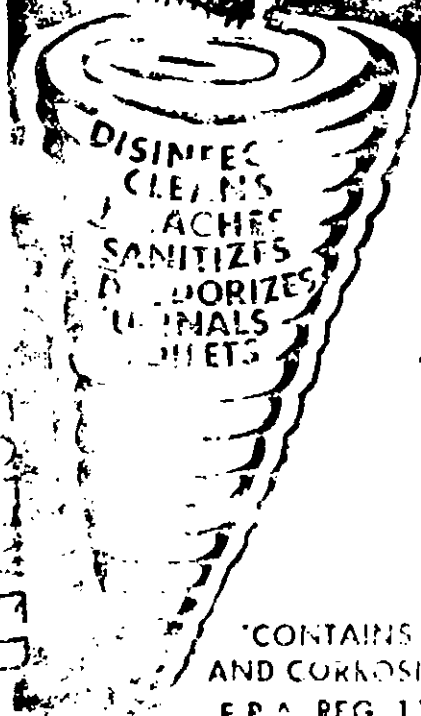

CLEANER MUST BE SURE TO WET ENTIRE SURFACE OF GROOVES, ALONG SIDE, AT WATER LINE OF URINAL. AFTER SURFACE IS CLEAN, AT URINAL TRAP AND POUR MINUTE AMOUNT AROUND DRAIN OPENING. ALLOW CLEANER TO WORK 10 MINUTES. CLEAN PIPE THOROUGHLY. REPLACE CLEANER MADE FOR INDUSTRIAL AND INSURANCE USE. PRODUCT OF CHEMICAL COMPANY. KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE. IF SWALLOWED CALL FOR FIRST AID. DRINK A TEASPOON OR MORE OF MILK OR A CUP OF SOAPY WATER FOLLOWED BY EGG WHITE. EYE CONTACT WASH WITH WATER. PROMPT MEDICAL ATTENTION. SKIN CONTACT WIPE OFF THE CLEANER. FLOOD THE SURFACE WITH WATER. THEN COVER WITH MOIST MATERIAL. NOTE: EMPTY CONTAINER AND DISINFECTANT. DISPOSING IN CASE OF SPILLAGE. AVOID SPLASHING ON NEARBY SURFACES. CONTAINER CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE. BLEACH OR OTHER CHEMICALS.
