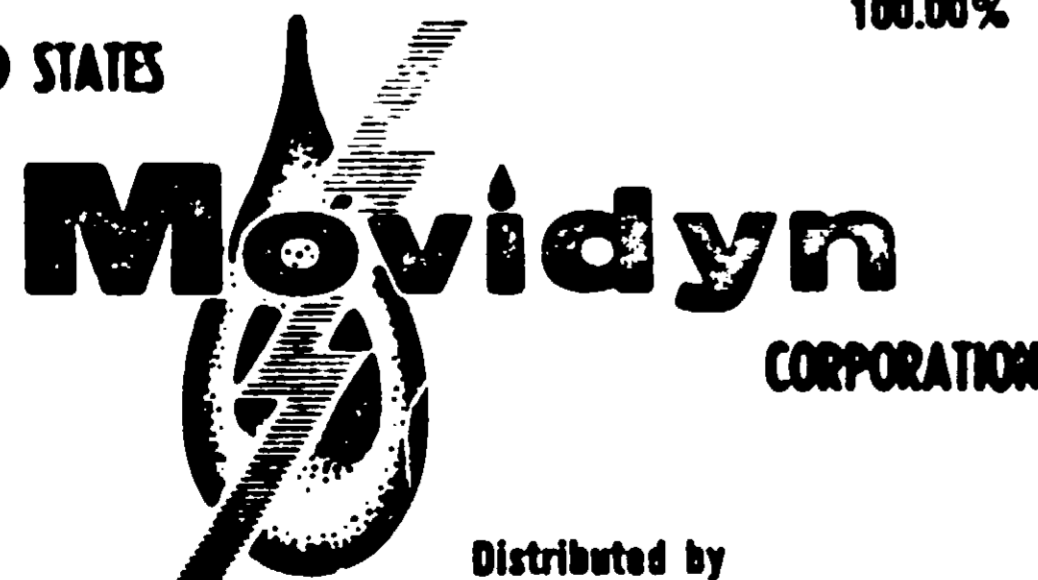

**HOW TO USE**

**Algaedyn**<sup>®</sup>

**TO KILL ALGAE IN YOUR SWIMMING POOL  
 BEFORE ADDING ALGAEDYN**

1. Backwash Filter.
2. THOROUGHLY CLEAN ALL TILE AREAS. Drop water line to approximately 1 inch of Bottom of Tile.
3. Adjust PH to 7.2.
4. Prepare the pool water for the use of ALGAEDYN by adding 2 quarts of 15% Sodium hypochlorite or 10 ozs. of 70% Calcium hypochlorite per quart of ALGAEDYN. Allow about 15 minutes for dispersion. Keep circulation system on during application and for 24 hours after treatment.

→ **NOTE: DO NOT USE IN A PAINTED POOL**

5. Initial dose, add 1 quart of ALGAEDYN per 10,000 gallons of water through the skimmer or beneath the water UNDER a filter return line. There may be a temporary discoloration which will clear shortly.

**AFTER ADDING ALGAEDYN**

6. Maintain residual chlorine concentrations at 0.6 to 1.0 ppm as determined by a chlorine test kit. Keep tile areas thoroughly clean.
7. Within 3 to 4 weeks the black algae will begin to lighten in color or turn gray. Brush down pool surface to remove this dead algae. A stainless steel brush is recommended.

**TO PREVENT ALGAE GROWTH IN POOLS FREE OF VISIBLE ALGAE**

Once a week, add 4 ozs. of ALGAEDYN per 10,000 gallons of water. Follow procedures 1 to 3. Prior to the addition of ALGAEDYN, add 8 ozs. of 15% Sodium hypochlorite or 2 ozs. of 70% Calcium hypochlorite per 10,000 gallons.

**TO WINTERIZE POOL AND PREVENT ALGAE, add 1 quart of**

Algaedyn per 10,000 gallons with circulating system on for dispersion, as late as possible before freezing.

This product is toxic to fish.

Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
