**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Stabilize pool water with Chlorine Conditioner (follow label directions). Add 1 quart Olean Pool Sanitizer/20,000 gallons water, check available chlorine with suitable test kit. If below one PPM, add increments of 3 oz./20,000 gal. every other day or as needed to maintain 1.0-1.5 PPM available chlorine. Product degrades with age. Use a test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine. Maintain water pH at 7.2 - 7.6 as determined with a suitable test kit.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** STORE IN A COOL, DRY AREA AWAY FROM DIRECT SUNLIGHT. IN CASE OF SPILL, FLOOD AREA WITH LARGE QUANTITIES OF WATER, RINSE EMPTY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY WITH WATER AND EITHER RETURN TO MANUFACTURER OR DISCARD BY PLACING IN TRASH COLLECTION OR BURYING IN AN APPROVED LANDFILL. PRODUCT OR RINSE THAT CANNOT BE USED SHOULD BE DILUTED WITH WATER AND DISPOSED OF IN A SANITARY SEWER. DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE, DISPOSAL OR CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT.
