The submission referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. The Ingredient Statement, Child Hazard Warning, and Signal Word must all appear on the front panel. For the correct placement of the label elements see the enclosure titled THE LABEL.
 - b. Add the following misuse statement under the USE DIRECTIONS heading:

It is a violation of Federal law to use
this product in a manner inconsistent
with its labeling.
 - c. Delete the statement "Only For Sale To, Use, and Storage By Service Persons."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

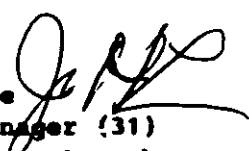

USE DIRECTIONS

SCHOOLS, OFFICES, HOUSEHOLDS

For sanitizing and disinfecting floors, walls, and inanimate hard surfaces (garbage pails, sink tops, etc.), first clean surfaces thoroughly. For sanitizing, make up solution of 1 oz. SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER to 4 gallons of water. For disinfecting, make up solution of 3 oz. SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER to 5 gallons of water. Kills *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Salmonella choleraesuis*. Apply solution with mop or cloth.

For sanitizing and disinfecting toilet bowls: make up solution of 3 oz. SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER and 4 gallons of water and add to water already in the bowl. Apply solution with mop or cloth.

HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, INSTITUTIONS, RESTROOMS

For floors, walls, and other hard surfaces, as well as sink tops, garbage pails, and telephones first clean surfaces thoroughly. Use SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER at 3 1/2 oz. per 5 gallons of water. At this level, SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRD-10.

FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT

For sanitization of food processing equipment and food utensils: first clean and rinse the equipment thoroughly. Then, dilute 1 oz. of SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER per 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternary. At this level, NO POTABLE WATER RINSE is required.

LAIRIES

To sanitize dairy equipment, first clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then apply sanitizing solution containing 1 oz. SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm). At this level, NO POTABLE WATER RINSE is required. Follow recommendations of local Health Board.

COLD DISINFECTION

For disinfection of previously-cleaned surgical instruments, barber tools, and dental equipment, simply submerge instruments into solution containing 1 1/2 oz. SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER per gallon of water.

RESTAURANT AND BAR RINSE

Dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking utensils: wash with soap or synthetic detergent, rinse thoroughly, immerse in a sanitizing solution containing 1 oz. of SERCO LIQUID SANITIZER to 4 gallons of water. NO TERMINAL POTABLE WATER RINSE is required.
