

# GIANT KILLER

## CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not spray near water containing fish.

Keep container closed. Do not leave in sunshine. Destroy this container when empty.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

## DIRECTIONS

LANE LABORATORIES GIANTKILLER is prepared especially for use against flies, fleas, bedbugs, mosquitoes and clothes moths. Use this material as it comes from the container.

**FLIES AND MOSQUITOES:** Close doors and windows in rooms to be treated. Direct a heavy cloud of GIANT KILLER spray upward into room. Fill entire room with vapor. Doors and windows should remain closed for 15 or 20 minutes. At the end of that time, open room and sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatments when necessary. Do not spray directly on food.

**FLEAS:** Thoroughly spray infested areas, taking care to work the spray into all cracks, baseboards, floor coverings, and other hiding places, particularly in the sleeping quarters of animals.

**BEDBUGS:** Thoroughly spray infested rooms, beds and mattresses. Cover floors, walls and ceilings. Pay particular attention to baseboards, cracks, corners and other insect hiding places. Using an oil can, saturate springs and bed. Spray other furniture, being certain to wet seams and corners. Repeat each week for a total of three or four applications. This should give complete control. If insects reappear, make additional treatments until control is obtained. Be sure mattresses are dry before using.

**CLOTHES MOTHS:** Clean and air infested garments. Thoroughly spray with GIANT KILLER, giving special attention to seams and pockets. Spray all interior surfaces of storage containers, such as closets and trunks. Repeat this treatment of garments and storage containers each month unless articles are stored in moth-tight containers. Be sure garments are dry before using.

Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.
