### ANTIDOTE

**INTERNAL:** To induce vomiting immediately, give  
two or three glasses of warm water having three  
teaspoonfuls of table salt dissolved in each. Re-

CIAN IMMEDIATELY.**

**NOTE TO ATTENDING PHYSICIAN:** Active in-  
gredient is a metabolic stimulant. Treat sympto-  
matically.
