PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Do not get in eyes, on skin or in clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

SANITIZ-IT is a concentrated bactericide solution useful as a disinfectant, sanitizer and deodorant. It should be diluted according to instructions prior to use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

In order to remove gross food particles and soil, prescrape or preflush before cleaning. Presoak if necessary. Thoroughly wash surfaces or objects with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse before application of the sanitizing solution.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate semicritical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

HOUSEHOLD

For sanitizing and disinfecting walls, floors, and inanimate hard surfaces. For Schools, Homes, Locker Rooms, Garbage Pails, Sink Tops, Corridors, Classrooms, Offices, Showers Stalls and Toilet Seats preclean as above. Apply solution with mop or cloth wetting all surfaces thoroughly. Sanitize with 1 oz. SANITIZ-IT to 4 gallons of water leaving solution on surface. Kills Staphylococcus aureus and Salmonella choleraesuis.
