

- d. Delete, "Only for Sale To, Use and Storage by Service, Maintenance or Janitorial Personnel." In its place add the wording "RECOMMENDED FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL USE."
- e. Preceding the Human Hazard statement add the heading, "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS."
- f. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment section, we suggest either underlining or using bold print for the subheadings, "If swallowed, If inhaled, If on skin, and If in eyes."
- g. Please revise the Environmental Hazards section to read:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife.
 Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.
 Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to fish in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Cover or incorporate spills.

- h. Please revise these Storage and Disposal statements as follows:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS WARNING

Poisoning may occur as a result of exposure. May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of the reach of children. Wash thoroughly after handling. Food utensils such as a teaspoon or measuring cup should not be used for food purposes after use with insecticides. STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or 15 mL.) of syrup or ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately.

If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes, flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: O,O-Diethyl S-(2-(ethylthio)ethyl) phosphorodithioate is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate is antidotal only if signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
