PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of
spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Contact with skin, eyes
or clothing should also be avoided. Wear protective gloves when making applications.
Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation
areas.

Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children.
Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with warm water after handling. Wash
contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.
Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to
contact treated surfaces until they are dry. Do not apply to animals.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep
quiet.

If on skin, wash immediately with soap and warm water. If irritation occurs, get
medical attention.

If eyes are contaminated, wash with plenty of water. Get medical attention. If inhaled,
remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get
medical attention. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce
vomiting. Vomiting may cause an aspiration hazard.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: A sense of tightness in chest. Sweating. Contracted pupils.
Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

ANTIDOTE: Administer atropine sulfate in therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to point
of tolerance.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system.
The parasympathetic nervous system and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine.
Watch for pulmonary edema which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12
hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and
treated symptomatically.

This product is toxic to fish, birds, other wildlife. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of

RESIDUAL SPRAY is a highly effective formulation which provides rapid kill of the crawling
insects as listed on the front panel, including those resistant to certain chlorinated
hydrocarbon and phosphate insecticides.

In addition to rapid initial kill, RESIDUAL SPRAY stays on treated surfaces and kills insects
many weeks after the spray deposits have dried. Do not use as a space spray.

HOW TO USE RESIDUAL SPRAY: is ready to use undiluted as it comes from the can,
and must be applied with either power operated or hand pressurized sprayers. This product
shall not be distributed, or sold, or used with finger-operated or trigger type sprayers. Apply
as a coarse spray to surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent
excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Direct spray away from people,
plants, and pets. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contamination of
feed, food, food processing equipment and food handling surfaces.

Indoor Use

**ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-
TOOTH GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGE), WATERBUGS.** Spray into cracks,
crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and
beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For
ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Do not spray
foodstuffs or house plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Applications
may be made to floor surfaces, along baseboards and around ducts, however, do not
treat entire area of floor or floor coverings. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces
until surfaces are completely dry.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and
door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floor. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding
should be placed in animal quarters after spraying.

Do not spray animals.

Outdoor Use

**ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, FLIES, HORNETS, MILLIPEDES,
MOSQUITOES, SCWBUGS, WASPS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS:** Spray thoroughly those
areas where pests have been seen or found including outside surfaces of screens, doors,
window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants,
spray runways. For control of wasps and hornets apply into dark when all of the insects have
returned to the nest. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

RESTRICTIONS: Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper, or similar materials
that may be stained. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces and
tiles and floor coverings.

FOR USE IN MEAT PACKAGING & FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: Use only in the inedible
areas of meat packing plants. Any exposed food products, equipment or packaging
materials must be removed or covered before spraying. Wash all equipment with an
effective cleaning compound followed by a rinse with potable water before resuming
operations. Treat food processing plants early in the season before canning or other
processing begins. Repeat applications if necessary, when plant is not in operation.
Spraying unloading docks and outside areas where insects congregate will aid in
preventing reinfestation. Good sanitation and proper disposal of wastes is essential in any
effective insect control program.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

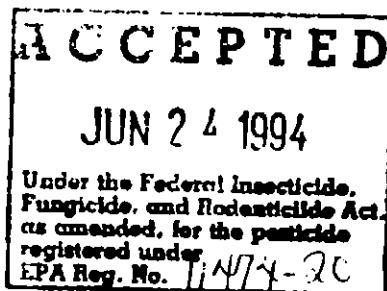
Pesticide Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes
resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste
disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or
puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and
local authorities.

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other
pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of
children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If container is leaking invert to
prevent leakage. If the container is leaking or material is spilled for any reason or cause,
carefully dam up spilled material to prevent runoff. Refer to Precautionary Statements on
label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled
material. Absorb spilled material with absorbing type compounds and dispose of as
directed for pesticides above. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away. You
