

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Read the entire directions and conditions before using. **RESIDUAL SPRAY** is a highly effective formulation which provides rapid kill of the crawling insects as listed on the front panel, including those resistant to certain chlorinated hydrocarbon and phosphate insecticides. In addition to rapid initial kill, **RESIDUAL SPRAY** stays on treated surfaces and kills insects many weeks after the spray deposits have dried.

HOW TO USE: **RESIDUAL SPRAY** is ready to use undiluted as it comes from the can, and must be applied with either power operated or hand pressurized sprayers. Apply as a coarse spray to surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Direct spray away from people, plants, and pets.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

INDOOR USE:

ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTH GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGE), WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Applications may be made to floor surfaces along baseboards and around air ducts, however, do not treat entire area of floor or floor coverings. **BROWN DOG TICKS:** Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying.

OUTDOOR USE:

ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, FLIES, HORNETS, MILLIPEDES, MOSQUITOES, SOWBUGS, WASPS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray thoroughly those areas where pests have been seen or found including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray runways. For control of wasps and hornet apply after dark when all of the insects have returned to the nest. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not apply as a landscape treatment (to lawns, shrubs or trees, garden plants).

FOR USE IN MEAT PACKAGING & FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: Use only in the inedible areas of meat packing plants. Any exposed food products, equipment or packaging materials must be removed or covered before spraying. Wash all equipment with an effective cleaning compound followed by a rinse with potable water before resuming operations. Treat food processing plants early in the season before canning or other processing begins. Repeat applications if necessary, when plant is not in operation. Spraying unloading docks and outside areas where insects congregate will aid in preventing reinfestation. Good sanitation and proper disposal of wastes is essential in any effective insect control program.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or indirectly. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply to animals. This product shall not be distributed, sold, or used with finger-operated trigger sprayers. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation areas. Avoid contamination of feed, food, food processing equipment and food handling surfaces. Remove pets and cover fish bowls or aquaria before spraying. Do not use as a space spray. Provide adequate ventilation of areas being treated. Do not spray vegetation. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly dry. Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper, or similar materials that may be stained. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces and tiles and floor coverings. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. If container is leaking invert to prevent leakage. If the container is leaking or material is spilled for any reason or cause, carefully dam up spilled material to prevent runoff. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Absorb spilled material with absorbing type compounds and dispose of as directed for pesticides above. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

FIRST AID:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

This product may pose an aspiration pneumonia hazard. Contains petroleum distillate. If gastric lavage is deemed necessary, undertake only after proper placement of a cuffed endotracheal tube.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: A sense of "tightness" in chest. Sweating. Contracted pupils. Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea.

ANTIDOTE: Administer atropine sulfate in therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to point of tolerance.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system. The parasympathetic nervous system and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.
